



## What to do at the Marsh:

(Dogs must be on a leash April 15 thru July 31 for the protection of ground nesting wildlife)

## Safety Rules

For your safety and to protect the Wildlife Area the following rules have been established:

- No motorized vehicles
- Bicycle slowly
- Carry out all litter
- No camping or overnight parking
- Do not block entry or exit gates
- No hunting from dikes, except deer during gun deer season
- No biking September 1 to April 30
- No riding horses
- No collecting

## What is the McMillan Marsh?

The McMillan Marsh Wildlife Area (MMWA) is a green oasis which lies to the immediate north/northwest of Marshfield. This area is felt to be an invaluable "recreational asset" and "environmental safeguard" to the citizens of Central Wisconsin.

The filtering and purifying value of the wetlands also contributes significantly to clean surface and drinking water.

Because northwest winds pre-dominate the area, this green space along with the farms northwest of Marshfield, ensures the city is constantly bathed with clean air.

The MMWA provides quality & varied recreational opportunities to the citizens of Wisconsin. It's a great place to hunt, trap, watch birds, hike, bike, take photos, snowmobile, or just walk the dog.

# McMillan Marsh Wildlife Area



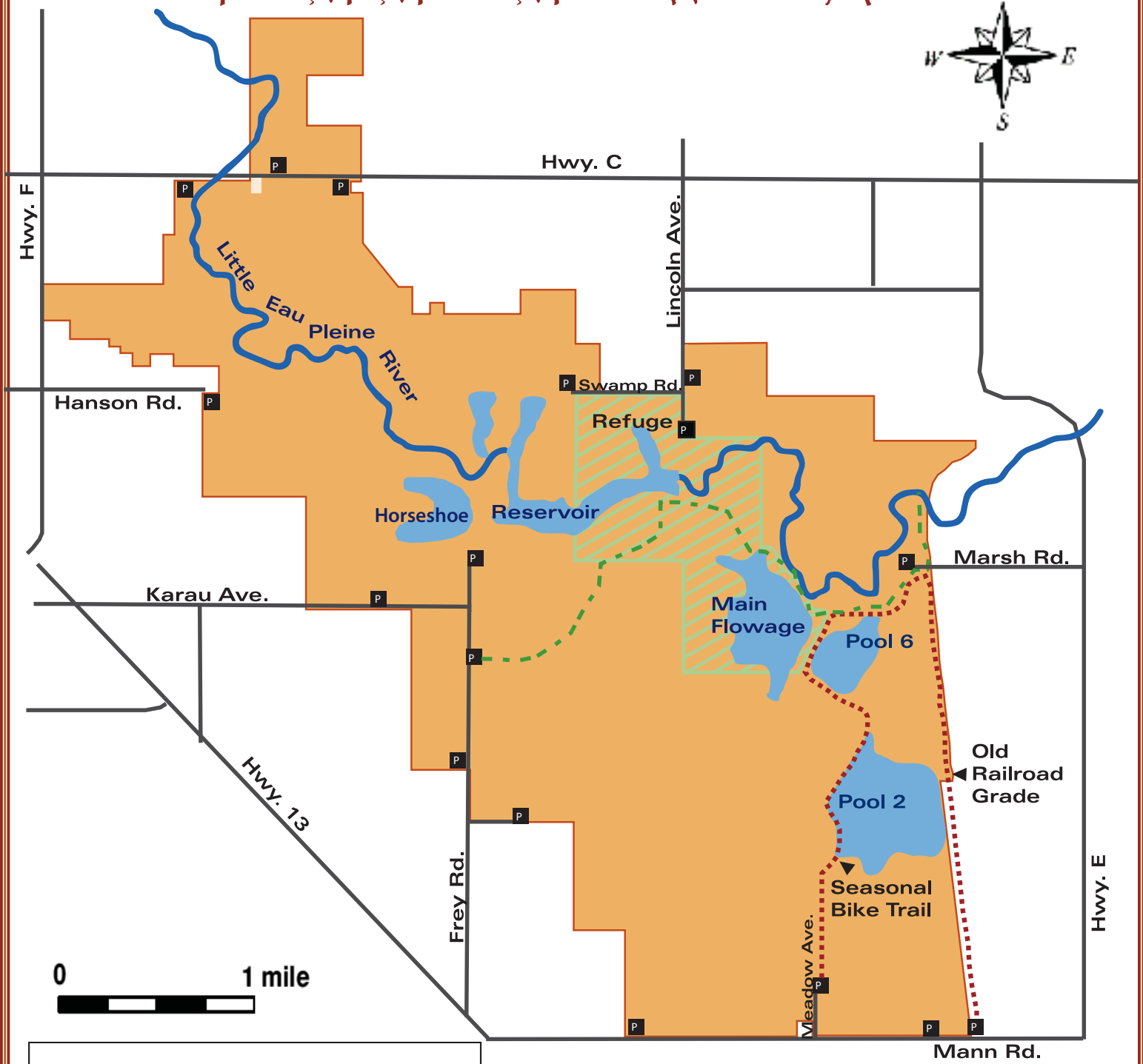

This wildlife area is managed by Department of Natural Resources (DNR) personnel stationed at the George W. Mead Wildlife Area Headquarters. The property is open to hunting and trapping during the regular seasons, except for the designated refuge area. Waterfowl need this feeding and resting area to “refuel” during the fall migration. Please do not enter the refuge during this critical time. A seasonal 5½ mile bicycle trail is open from May 1 to August 31. Trail begins at the end of Meadow Avenue.
